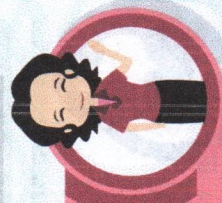


## Local Development Council and Local Peace and Order Council

## RCSP Core Team



The RCSP Core Team shall serve as the unit that directly provides all necessary tactical, technical, logistical and administrative assistance to the LCE in the performance of its function as the RCSP head. The DILG City/Municipal Local Government Operations Officer shall head the Core Team

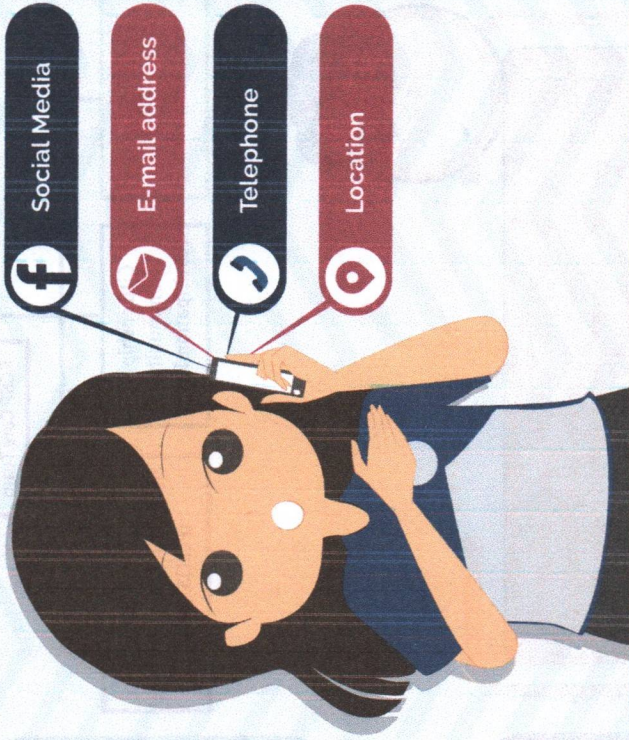

## Background:

Cognizant that the 50-year communist-terrorist problem cannot be solved and ended solely by the military, President Duterte issued Executive Order No. 701 which calls for a whole-of-nation approach in dealing with the root causes of local armed conflict.

EO 70 aims to integrate the efforts of national and local government stakeholders in areas to prioritize the delivery of basic government services, social development packages and construction of needed infrastructure in areas which are threatened and vulnerable to communist terrorist groups.

To support the objectives of EO 70, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) conceptualized the Retooled Community Support Program (RCSP).

*EO 70 - Institutionalizing the Whole of Nation Approach in Attaining Inclusive Growth and Sustainable Peace, Creating a National Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict, and Directing the Adoption of a National Peace Framework*



## What is the Retooled Community Support Program (RCSP)?

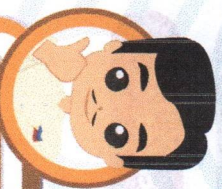
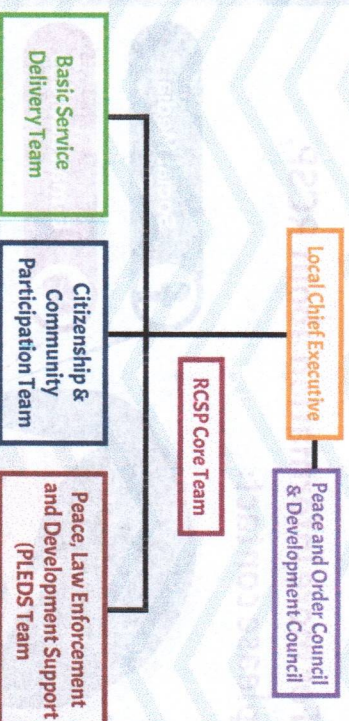
RCSP is an inclusive program that aims to address the issues identified by the communities themselves through the provision of government projects while ensuring sustainable development and promoting peace.

Under the program, an RCSP team composed of military and local government stakeholders conducts immersion in the target barangays to assess the needs and concerns of the local populace and address the same in order to uplift their living conditions and enhance development in the area.

## Organization of RCSP Team and RCSP Core Team

RCSP Teams shall be created from the provincial, city, and municipal level to spearhead the operationalization of the RCSP. The creation of RCSP Team shall follow this prescribed structure:

### Local Chief Executive

As head of the RCSP Team, he shall be at the forefront of bringing the needed government interventions to the people through RCSP. He/She shall also be in-charge of the deployment of the RCSP Team to the target barangay for immersion and ensure that development initiatives are delivered, immediate needs addressed, and long-term needs programmed for funding and implementation.

### Basic Service Delivery Team



It is tasked to serve as the primary bridge of the RCSP Team to the national government. It shall be composed of two teams - BSDT Team 1 representing NGAS and BSDT Team 2 for NGAS at the regional and provincial level.

*BSDT members - DA, DAR, DENR, DSW, DSH, DepEd, CHED, TESDA, DSWD, NCRP*



### Citizenship and Community Participation Team

It is tasked to organize the citizenship movement by mobilizing communities into sectoral groups and ushering them to participate in all sectoral dialogues aimed to validate development gaps and identify the needed government interventions to address them.

*CCPT members - LCU dept head, punong barangay, sangguniang barangay members, principal/head teacher of public school in the barangay, SK chairperson, lupong tagapamunayo, designated member from RCSP Core Team, rep from barangay public safety officers, interfaith groups, public sector, media and local CSO/PO, congressional rep.*

### Peace, Law Enforcement & Development Support Team



It is tasked to conduct clearing operations prior to the actual send-off of the RCSP Team, ensure perimeter security of the target barangay during the immersion, and conduct continuous sanitation of the community from terrorist threats during the implementation and provision of needed government interventions.

*PLEDS members - AFP rep, two uniformed personnel each from the PNP, BMR, and BRP, and former rebels available in the area*

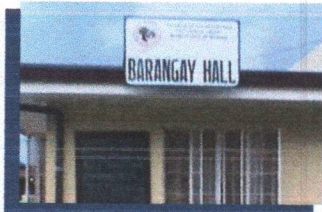
